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## OLA CODE OF CONDUCT

### Section I – All individuals affiliated with the OLA shall:

- I. Attempt at all times to work toward the goals and objectives of the OLA and the game of Lacrosse, and towards the betterment of its members.
- II. Strive to heighten the image and dignity of the Association and the sport of Lacrosse as a whole, and to refrain from behaviour which may discredit or embarrass the Association or the game.
- III. Always be courteous and objective in dealing with other members.
- IV. Strive to achieve excellence in the sport while supporting the concepts of Fair Play and Drug free sport.
- V. Show respect for the culture, social and political values of all participants in the sport.
- VI. As a guest in another province or foreign country, abide by the laws of the host jurisdiction and adhere to any social customs concerning conduct.

### Section II – An Individual's conduct shall be in question when they:

- I. Breach any of the above Section 1.
- II. Use their position within the OLA for unauthorized personal and/or material gains.
- III. Willfully circulate false, malicious statements, derogatory to any other member of the Association.
- IV. Willfully ignore or break the Bylaws, policies and/or rules and regulations of the OLA.
- V. Counsel others to ignore or break the bylaws, policies, and/or rules and regulations of the OLA.

### Section III – General:

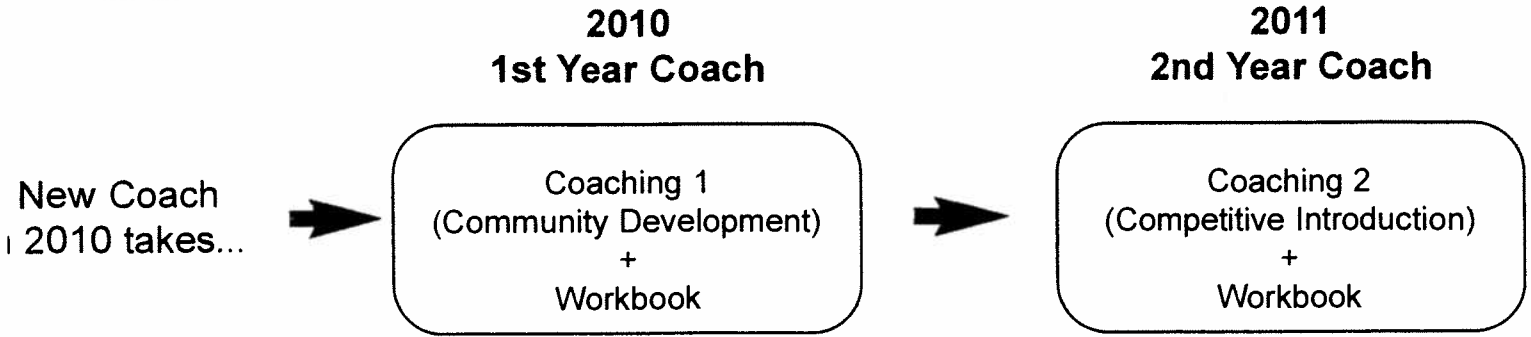
- I. The OLA endorses the principles of natural justice and due process which allows any individual the right to a hearing and an appeal of any action which affects their rights.
- II. The OLA and its member governing bodies agree to honor and enforce disciplinary action taken by those governing bodies upon the completion of due process.

### Section IV – Discipline Procedures:

- I. Any report alleging a breach of Member obligation under this Code of Conduct shall be submitted in writing to the OLA within fourteen (14) days of the event/occurrence.
- II. Upon receiving a report, the OLA staff shall immediately notify the OLA Executive who shall determine the merit of the complaint and determine if action is necessary.
- III. If action is deemed necessary, the event/occurrence will be dealt with under normal OLA Discipline and Appeals procedures.

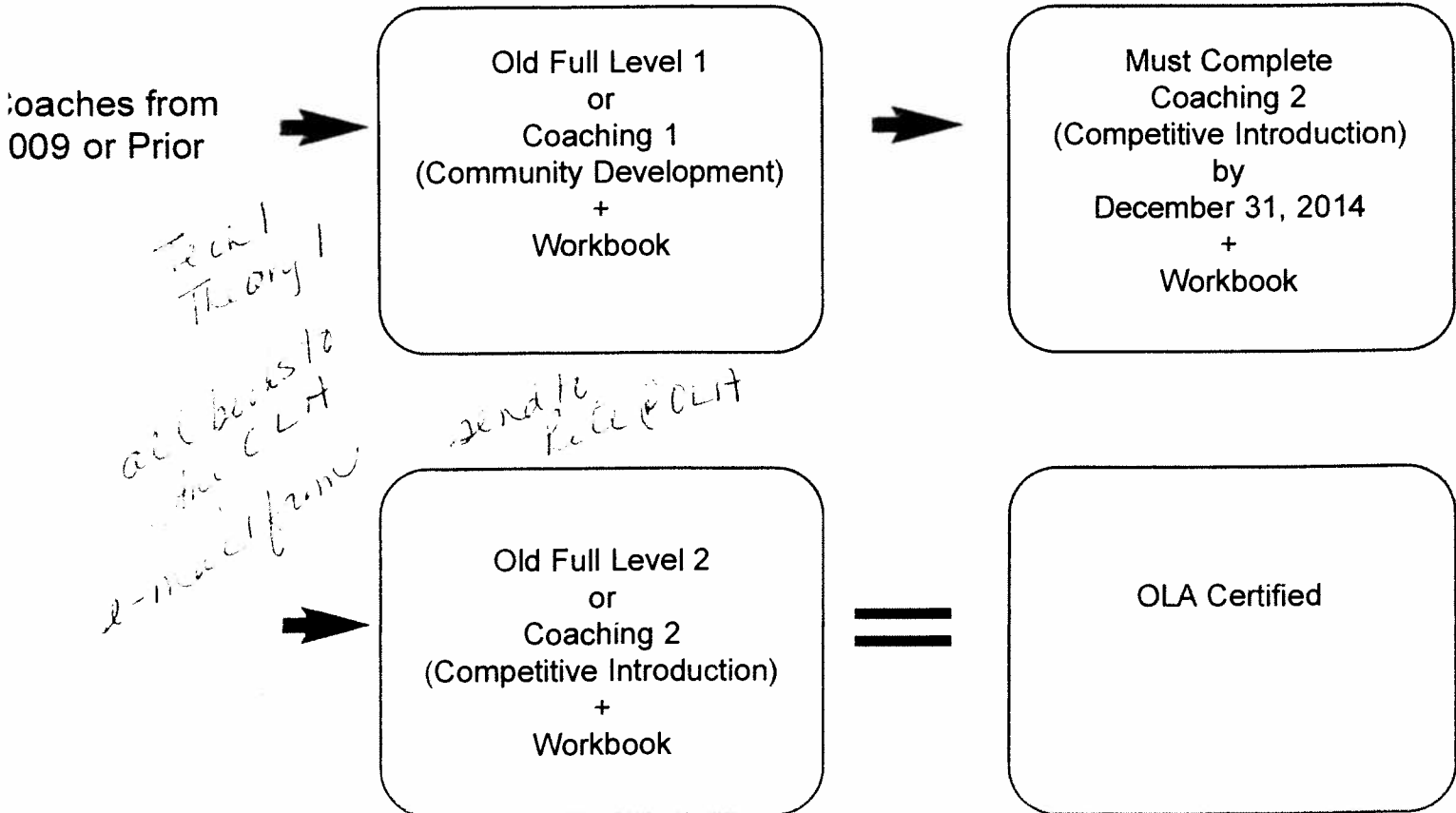


# 2010-11 OLA COACHING REQUIREMENTS for Box & Field Lacrosse

## REGISTRAR'S NOTES TO COACHES 2010

**DEADLINE** for submission of Coaches, Trainers, and Managers blue OLA Registration forms to BMLA Registrar is **Monday, April 26th.**

### **White Stan-Stamped Cards**

Please note that there is a minimum of a **3-4 week turnaround** to receive the white Stan-stamped cards back from the OLA. As such, for those Teams attending early tournaments at the end of May beginning of June (i.e. the **Laker Classic in Peterborough**) you **MUST** have all of your bench staff (Coaches, Trainer and Manager) Blue OLA Registration forms and credentials to the BMLA Registrar no later than **April 26<sup>th</sup>**. Any forms not received by this date are not guaranteed to be back in time for your tournament. Which means they will not be allowed on the bench. If you have a Coach who is also a Trainer, I would suggest you have them provide their Trainer credentials as well so that their card can be stamped Coach/Trainer.

Coaches, when you have picked your team please provide the BMLA Registrar with a Team List no later than April 26<sup>th</sup> so that the Stan-stamped cards can be pulled. Please also provide her with the names of your Assistant Coaches, Trainer(s) and Manager.

### **Coaching Requirements for the 2010 season**

#### **New Coach**

- 1) First year Coach must take Coaching 1 (Community & Development + workbook).
- 2) You must provide the BMLA Registrar with a photocopy of the Card provided to you at the Coaching Clinic. This must be submitted with your signed Blue OLA Registration form.
- 3) Prior to March 2011, the new coach **MUST** submit their Workbook to Peter Flook at the OLA. Peter will then forward it on to Ron St. Croix at the CLA for marking. **KEEP A PHOTOCOPY OF YOUR WORKBOOK** as they have been known to get lost.

### Coaches who took a Coaching Clinic in 2009 or earlier

- 1) You must have the Old Full Level 1 or Coaching 1 (Community Development and Workbook). Your workbook MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE OLA PRIOR TO MARCH 31, 2010.

**NOTE:** If your workbook is **NOT** submitted prior to **March 31, 2010**, you will be required to **retake** Coaching 1. This will not be reimbursed by BMLA. Please advise the BMLA Registrar when you have submitted your workbook.

- 2) Coaching 2 (Competitive Introduction and submit your workbook) must be completed by December 31, 2014.
- 3) The Old Full Level 2 or Coaching 2 (Competitive Introduction and workbook) in 2009 is considered OLA certified.

*\*\*A list of dates and locations for Coaching Clinics is attached.*

### Assistant Coaches

- 1) Require the same credentials as the Head Coach;
- 2) They must complete and sign a Blue OLA Registration form and provide a photocopy of their card.

### Trainer

- 1) They must complete and sign a Blue OLA Registration form and provide a photocopy of their credentials.

Require at least one of the following:

- 1) St. John Ambulance *Emergency First Aid* course of 8 hours (or more);
- 2) Canadian Red Cross *Standard First Aid & Basic Rescuer CPR* course;
- 3) Sport Alliance of Ontario/Canadian Red Cross *Sports First Aid* course;
- 4) Ontario Hockey Trainer's Certification Program;
- 5) A professional designation (examples: MD; RN; Policeman; Fireman). (**\*the party must submit their designation card and it must be dated with a current year validation**)

**Manager:**

1. They must complete and sign a Blue OLA Registration form.

## **NON ZONE GAME GUIDELINES 2007**

The purpose of creating this guideline is to ensure that all organizers of Non Zone games are aware of the OLA Constitutional regulations and their responsibilities as participants.

These guidelines are applicable for all Non Zone Games, including exhibition, interlock games, and Fun Days

### **NON ZONE GAMES MAY NOT BE SCHEDULED UNTIL THE ZONE SCHEDULE IS FINALIZED**

**All teams are must fulfil ALL of their Zone responsibilities. Non Zone games will not be authorized if a team has not fulfilled their Zone responsibilities.**

#### **MR6.01**

*"Teams in the Corporation shall not be allowed to play matches with teams or players who have been suspended or expelled for the Corporation during the period of such suspension or expulsion. Clubs so doing knowingly shall be suspended automatically, subject to ruling by the Board of Directors."*

#### **MR 6.02**

*"All clubs or players intending to take part in non zone games must advise presidents of both clubs, zone directors in corresponding zones of their intent to play such games. All players of the said clubs must be in good standing and games sheets for the games must be forwarded by the home club to the Zone Director and the Corporation within 48 hrs."*

*Also to the VP Minor*

#### **MR6.03**

*"A player shall not play in an exhibition game or tournament unless as a member of the association with which he/she is signed."*

## Non Zone Games Guidelines 2007

- No scheduled games for Peewee, Bantam, Midget "A" rated teams after July 8<sup>th</sup> of the current playing year.
- No games may be added to the schedule to act as a vehicle to serve suspensions.
- The Zone in which the game is played is responsible for any discipline, except for Abuse of an Official and bench clearing, which goes directly to the OLA. Notification must be made to the OLA immediately.
- Any fines incurred as a result of these games assessed at Zone level will be made payable to the Zone of the offending centre.
- Any team not paying fines within 30 days of assessment will risk their standing within their Zone and the OLA. Should collection of these fines become an issue it will be dealt with between Zones.
- All suspensions must be reported to the OLA office within 48 hours (max) Records of suspensions served must be sent to the OLA office as well as the Zone Director of both centres
- The referee assignor for the home centre will be asked to assign referees for the game
- Costs of such games will be mutually agreed upon by both teams, payment, if required made by cheque or money order, not cash, made payable to the Club, not to an individual.

### GAME SHEETS

- Home club must forward (fax, email, mail) top copy of the game sheet to their Zone director (who will forward to the other Zone) the Corporation (OLA office) and to VP Minor within 48 hrs. Information regarding any suspensions should be telephoned within 24 hrs to those listed above.
- Any game sheet showing suspensions served as a result of non-zone games must be forwarded to those listed above for tracking purposes.

# Fun Day Guidelines 2007

- Restricted for play from Paperweight – Novice divisions only
- Maximum of 3 teams per division, one must be the host team
- Restricted to ONE host day per association per playing season.
- Must be approved by the Club President and Zone Director
- Must submit game sheets to the OLA office within 7 days of completion of day for tyke and novice divisions
- If an Invitational Tournament was not granted due to non filing of paperwork OR alcohol served at a Minor tournament a Fun Day will not be granted for that year

# Player Re-assignment

- Coach of team 1 calls all players to inform them if they made team 1 or were cut.
- Coach of team 2 calls all players who didn't make team 1 and welcomes them to team 2.
- No e-mails, posted lists, phone messages.

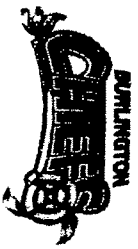
